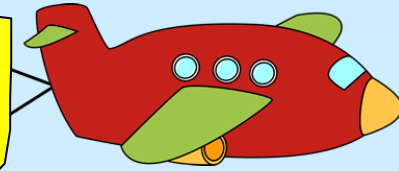




Climax/problem: Things might go wrong! Is there a mystery or do terrible things happen? Are there any disagreements?
